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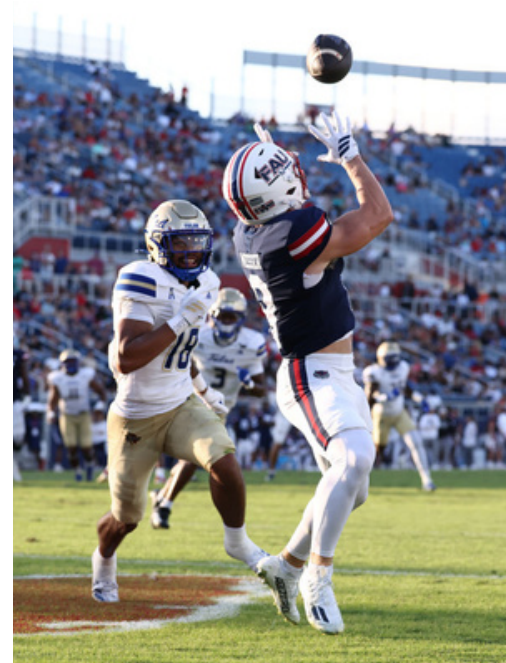
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NORTHSIDELINE MEDIA

NorthSideline Media is a **bilingual** sports outlet entering its **third consecutive season of credentialed NCAA football coverage**, producing original English- and French-language reporting on college football and the Canadian Football League. Based in North Vancouver, NorthSideline combines on-site reporting, interviews, features and game-day storytelling to connect North American football with audiences across Canada, France, Europe and the international francophone community.

The outlet is led by Founder & Editor-in-Chief **Rafael Claveau**, a member of the **Football Writers Association of America (FWAA)** and a U.S. **media visa (I-visa)** holder.

NorthSideline holds **full-season credentials with the Washington Huskies and BC Lions in 2026**, a third consecutive season with Washington and a second with BC. The outlet held full-season credentials with **Washington, BC and the Seattle Storm throughout 2025**.

WHY NORTHSIDELINE

Very few outlets provide consistent, credentialed, on-site college football coverage in **French**. French is spoken by hundreds of millions of people worldwide, including millions of Canadians and audiences across France, Belgium, Switzerland and West Africa, markets where college football receives comparatively limited first-hand coverage in the language.

NorthSideline gives the programs it covers a direct way to reach this underserved audience through original French-language reporting, while its English coverage extends that storytelling across North America and internationally. The goal is not simply to attend games, but to use media access to produce reporting that brings programs, athletes, traditions and stadium atmospheres to readers who rarely encounter them first-hand in French.

MEDIA ACCESS & CONDUCT

NorthSideline understands that **media access is a privilege**. The outlet follows all credential terms and event-specific rules established by athletic departments, conferences and host organizations, respects designated working areas and interview procedures, coordinates requests through communications staff, and provides published coverage links to programs following events.

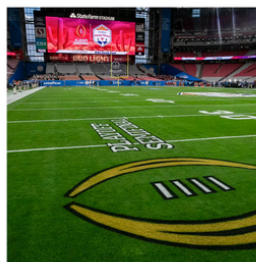

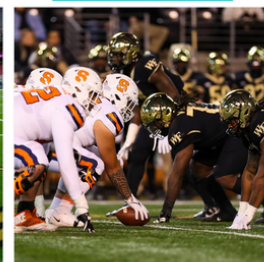
